- Vision and Goals #3 read and discuss: Attracting and retaining newcomers:
  - Newcomer meetings.
  - o Newcomer meetings 15 minutes before the meeting for members to share that OA means to them and to answer questions.
  - At bigger meetings, offer a separate smaller meeting for newcomers
  - Add a column to the meeting's We Care List: "If you want a call, check here"
  - Go through Doctor's Opinion with newcomers
  - o oa.org has guidelines
  - Someone should be there early to greet and give out a Newcomer's Packet (or give them the packet after the meeting, so they aren't looking through it during the meeting). The importance of the human element right away: hand shake before or after meeting.
  - If it is a Step Meeting, at the beginning of the meeting, have someone share what OA is doing for them
  - The pocket card with Steps, etc has a spot on it for phone numbers as does the Welcome Packet
